Acceptance of Terms

By accessing, browsing, or using the JP Electric Lifts website (jpelectriclifts.com) or any of our services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree to these terms, you must not use our website or services.

These Terms and Conditions apply to all visitors, users, customers, and anyone who accesses or uses the website or engages in equipment rental transactions with JP Electric (Jeta Group Inc., License C10 965963).

JP Electric reserves the right to modify, update, or change these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice. Your continued use of the website or services after any modifications constitutes your acceptance of the revised terms. Description of Services

JP Electric Lifts provides commercial and industrial heavy equipment rental services, including but not limited to scissor lifts, boom lifts, vertical mast lifts, mini excavators, forklifts, skid steers, compact track loaders, and associated attachments.

Our services include equipment delivery to and pick-up from customer jobsites across Garden Grove, Orange County, Los Angeles County, the Inland Empire, and throughout Southern California.

All equipment rentals are subject to availability. JP Electric reserves the right to substitute comparable equipment if the requested equipment is unavailable. Rental rates, fees, and surcharges are subject to change without notice. Contact us at (714) 863-8624 for current pricing and availability.

Rental Agreements

All equipment rentals are governed by a separate Rental Contract Agreement that must be executed by both parties prior to equipment delivery. The Rental Contract Agreement sets forth specific terms regarding rental period, charges, security deposits, delivery and return conditions, liability, insurance requirements, and equipment use restrictions.

In the event of any conflict between these Terms and Conditions and the Rental Contract Agreement, the Rental Contract Agreement shall prevail with respect to the specific rental transaction.

By entering into a Rental Contract Agreement with JP Electric, the renter (lessee) agrees to all terms contained therein, including but not limited to responsibility for the equipment from the time of delivery until its return, adherence to all safety requirements, and timely payment of all rental charges and applicable fees.

Use of Website

You agree to use the JP Electric Lifts website only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. You agree not to:

- Use the website in any way that violates any applicable federal, state, local, or international law or regulation.
- Engage in any conduct that restricts or inhibits anyone's use or enjoyment of the website, or which may harm JP Electric or users of the website.
- Use the website to transmit or send unsolicited commercial communications (spam).
- Attempt to gain unauthorized access to any part of the website, server, or any system or network connected to the website.
- Use any robot, spider, scraper, or other automated means to access the website for any purpose without our express written permission.
- Introduce any viruses, trojan horses, worms, logic bombs, or other malicious or technologically harmful material.
- Reproduce, duplicate, copy, sell, resell, or exploit any portion of the website without express written permission from JP Electric.

Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, JP Electric (Jeta Group Inc.), its officers, directors, employees, agents, affiliates, and representatives shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential, punitive, or exemplary damages, including but not limited to damages for loss of profits, goodwill, use, data, or other intangible losses, arising out of or in connection with:

- Your access to or use of (or inability to access or use) the website.
- Any conduct or content of any third party on the website.
- Any content obtained from the website.
- Unauthorized access, use, or alteration of your transmissions or content.
- Any errors, mistakes, or inaccuracies of content on the website.

Indemnification

This defense and indemnification obligation will survive the termination of these Terms and Conditions and your use of the website.

Equipment Safety and Operator Responsibility

All equipment rented from JP Electric must be operated by trained, qualified, and authorized personnel in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and safety standards, including but not limited to OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Administration), ANSI (American National Standards Institute), and EPA (Environmental Protection Agency) requirements.

The renter is solely responsible for ensuring that all operators are properly trained, licensed (where required), and competent to operate the specific equipment being rented. JP Electric shall not be liable for any injuries, deaths, property damage, or other losses resulting from improper operation, unauthorized use, or failure to follow manufacturer guidelines and safety protocols.

Renters must comply with all equipment surcharge policies, including but not limited to daily charging requirements, equipment cleanliness upon return, accessibility for pick-up, and fuel return requirements as outlined in the Rental Contract Agreement and on our website at jpelectriclifts.com/rental-info/surcharges.

Dispute Resolution and Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to its conflict of law provisions.

Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to these Terms and Conditions, or the breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, shall first be attempted to be resolved through good-faith negotiation between the parties. If the dispute cannot be resolved through negotiation within thirty (30) days, the parties agree to submit to mediation before a neutral third party in Orange County, California.

If mediation fails to resolve the dispute within sixty (60) days, either party may pursue binding arbitration or

litigation in a court of competent jurisdiction in Orange County, California. You agree to submit to the personal jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in Orange County, California for the purpose of litigating any such claims or disputes.

You agree that regardless of any statute or law to the contrary, any claim or cause of action arising out of or related to use of the website or these Terms and Conditions must be filed within one (1) year after such claim or cause of action arose, or be forever barred.

Severability

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of these Terms and Conditions, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect. The invalid or unenforceable provision shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid and enforceable while preserving the original intent of the parties.

Entire Agreement
